DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 25 2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF TWO STANDALONE CREEK RESTORATION PROJECTS TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM AND TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS FROM CIP ACC00001 TO CIP S-22008 UPPER AUBURN CREEK REVITALIZATION AND CIP S-22009 CHOLLAS CREEK RESTORATION 54TH ST. AND EUCLID AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization project area extends from south of University Avenue to north of Auburn Drive in the City Heights Community Plan Area in Council District 9; and

WHEREAS, Upper Auburn Creek, surrounding roads and properties experience frequent flooding due to lack of creek conveyance capacity; and

WHEREAS, Upper Auburn Creek shows signs of severe erosion caused by high-velocity flows and restricted creek capacity along much of the creek corridor; and

WHEREAS, significant illegal dumping occurs in the Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization project area, resulting in large amounts of trash and debris conveyed into Auburn Creek; and

WHEREAS, engineering, planning and future implementation of the Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization project will alleviate flooding and reduce erosion through: replacement and upgrade of existing severely undersized culverts; and realignment and widening of Auburn Creek from south of University Avenue to north of Auburn Drive; and

WHEREAS, engineering, planning and future implementation of the Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization project will reduce transport of trash and debris downstream during storms by construction of a water quality (biofiltration) basin near the intersection of Wightman Street and 50th Street; and

WHEREAS, the Chollas Creek Restoration 54th St. and Euclid Avenue (Chollas Creek Restoration) project area is located in the City Heights Community Plan Area in Council District 9; and

WHEREAS, the Chollas Creek Restoration project area extends along Chollas Creek from the culvert outlet at 54th Street downstream to a culvert outlet at Euclid Avenue; and

WHEREAS, within the Chollas Creek Restoration project area, Chollas Creek is adversely impacted by high-velocity, erosive flows at several locations and has very steep banks which are vulnerable to further degradation and erosion during even modest storms; and

WHEREAS, significant amounts of trash and debris are transported into this portion of Chollas Creek; and

WHEREAS, engineering, planning and future implementation of the Chollas Creek Restoration project will restore and enhance the Chollas Creek channel from 54th Street to Euclid Avenue by: stabilizing the stream bank to reduce erosive flows within the stream channel; improving the existing lateral storm drain infrastructure to reduce erosion; replacing an existing culvert at Euclid Avenue to increase stormwater conveyance capacity; including a water quality (biofiltration) basin to treat diverted flows; and including a Pedestrian bridge and trail along the Euclid Avenue to 54th Street portion of Chollas Creek; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create two standalone projects within the Capital Improvements Program and authorize the transfer of appropriations from CIP ACC00001, Stormwater Green Infrastructure to these two standalone projects, CIP S-22008 Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization and CIP S-22009 Chollas Creek Restoration 54th St. and Euclid Avenue, within Fund 400881, Debt Funded General Fund CIP to fund preliminary engineering and planning activities for the Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization project and the Chollas Creek Restoration project; and

HEREAS, these preliminary engineering and planning activities include cost estimates, schedules, funding plans and allocation, surveys, identification of constraints during design and future construction and Preliminary Environmental Assessments; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to add S-22008 Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization project to the Capital Improvements Program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer appropriations not to exceed \$250,000. from the Capital Improvements Program Budget in CIP ACC00001, Stormwater Green Infrastructure, to CIP S-22008 Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization within Fund 400881, Debt Funded General Fund CIP, for the purpose of funding preliminary engineering and planning activities for the Upper Auburn Creek Revitalization project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to add S-22009 Chollas Creek Restoration 54th St. and Euclid Avenue project to the Capital Improvements Program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer appropriations not to exceed \$250,000. from the Capital Improvements Program Budget in CIP ACC00001, Stormwater Green Infrastructure, to CIP S-22009 Chollas Creek Restoration 54th St. and Euclid Avenue within Fund 400881, Debt Funded General Fund CIP,

for the purpose of funding preliminary engineering and planning activities for the Chollas Creek Restoration 54th St. and Euclid Avenue project.
