A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$13,500 TO WORKSHOPS FOR WARRIORS, INC., FOR COMPUTERS WORKSTATIONS FOR THE ADVANCED MANUFACTURING TRAINING FOR YOUNG VETERANS PROGRAM, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, Workshops for Warriors, Inc., has requested funding for computer workstations for the machining and welding classrooms; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to purchase computer workstations for use by students participating in the Advanced Manufacturing Training for Young Veterans program; and

WHEREAS, Workshops for Warriors' request for funding for the computer workstations will benefit the public by boosting Workshops for Warriors' capability to provide high quality education and supporting veterans securing living wages and elevating themselves and their families out of poverty; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council Districts 1, 2, 5, 6, and 8 recommend a total allocation of \$13,500 to Workshops for Warriors for the purposes set forth in this resolution, attributed as follows: Council District 1 – \$2,500; Council District 2 – \$1,000; Council District 5 – \$2,500; Council District 6 – \$2,500; and Council District 8 – \$5,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: “An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2022 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and Workshops for Warriors (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$13,500 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- **313955**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$2,500 from Council District 1: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1101110001; \$1,000 from Council District 2: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1102110002; \$2,500 from Council District 5: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost

Center 1105110005; \$2,500 from Council District 6: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1106110006; and \$5,000 from Council District 8: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1108110008, for a total of \$13,500, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
