A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS TO ITALIAN AMERICAN ARTS AND CULTURE ASSOCIATION, MISSION HILLS TOWN COUNCIL, SAN DIEGO CIVIC YOUTH BALLET, AND TRANSCENDANCE YOUTH ARTS PROJECT, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego received and evaluated four applications for Community Projects, Programs and Services funding for the following purposes:

Italian American Arts and Culture Association	Across the Lines	Provide exposure to other cultures and new forms of expression
Mission Hills Town Council	Summer Concerts in Pioneer Park	Foster a sense of community and connection within Mission Hills.
San Diego Civic Youth Ballet	Ballet for the Classroom	Provide dance education to underprivileged students.

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$1,000 to Italian American Arts and Culture Association to venue rentals and technology support, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to Mission Hills Town Council for summer concert costs including sound equipment, permit fees, trash removal, and publicity, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$1,000 to San Diego Civic Youth Ballet for program expenses for school dance programs, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$1,000 to transcendANCE Youth Arts Project for production costs, including video, sound, and stage supplies, as set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for Italian American Arts and Culture Association, San Diego Civic Youth Ballet, and transcendANCE Youth Arts Project, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(b), which provides: "A request for funding and subsequent allocation may not be less than \$1500."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for all groups identified in this resolution, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, for the San Diego Civic Youth Ballet and transcenDANCE Youth Arts Project, the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: "Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2022 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and (1) Italian American Arts and Culture Association in an amount not to exceed \$1,000, (2) Mission Hills Town Council in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, (3) San Diego Civic Youth Ballet in an amount not to exceed \$1,000, and (4) transcenDANCE Youth Arts Project in an amount not to exceed \$1,000, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 314037-1 for Italian American Arts and Culture Association, Document No. RR- 314037-2 for Mission Hills Town Council, Document No. RR- 314037-3 for San Diego Civic Youth Ballet, and Document No. RR- 314037-4 for transcenDANCE Youth Arts Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$8,000 from Council District 3: Community Projects, Programs and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1103110003, all to

provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
