A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE, AND EXPENDITURE OF GRANT FUNDS FOR THE CALIFORNIA FISCAL YEAR 2022 DIRECT STATE GRANT BUDGET ALLOCATION FOR NEW SIDEWALKS, TRAFFIC CALMING, AND STREETLIGHTS TO SUPPORT FOUR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS: WOODMAN STREET-CIELO DRIVE TO PAGEL PLACE SIDEWALK, 54TH-MARKET TO SANTA MARGARITA SIDEWALK, ROLANDO PARK V-CALMING DEVICES, AND REO DRIVE STREETLIGHTS.

WHEREAS, California Fiscal Year 2022 Direct State Grant Budget Allocation grant funding is part of Assembly Bill-170 Budget Act of 2021 and the grant funds can be used for planning, design, and construction phases of qualified projects, with no expiration date and no fund matching requirement; and

WHEREAS, the following City projects are eligible to receive this grant funding: Woodman Street-Cielo Drive to Pagel Place Sidewalk Project (B-18159), 54th-Market to Santa Margarita Sidewalk (B-18158), Rolando Park V-Calming Devices Project (B-21099), and Reo Drive Streetlights Project (B-19079); and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation is currently preparing the funding allocation request packages and once completed, the City will submit funding allocation requests for \$823,000 in grant funding to be allocated to the four projects identified above for support of the future design and construction phases of the projects; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to take all necessary actions to make application to the State and to secure California Fiscal Year 2022

Direct State Grant Budget Allocation grant funding for an amount not to exceed \$823,000 in grant funding. Of the \$823,000 grant funding, \$200,000 is to be allocated to B-18159 Woodman Street-Cielo Drive to Pagel Place Sidewalk (Annual Allocation: AIK-00001), \$335,000 is to be allocated to B-18158 54th-Market to Santa Margarita Sidewalk (Annual Allocation: AIK-00001), \$18,000 is to be allocated to B-21099 Rolando Park V-Calming Devices (Annual Allocation: AIL-00001), and \$270,000 is to be allocated to B-19079 Reo Drive Streetlights (Annual Allocation: AIH-00001) to support design and construction phases.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend California Fiscal Year 2022 Direct State Grant Budget Allocation grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$823,000, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvement Program Budget in CIP: AIK-00001, New Walkways (B-18159, ADACA Woodman Street-Cielo to Pagel Place Sidewalk) and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$200,000; AIK-00001, New Walkways (B-18158, 54th-Market to Santa Margarita Sidewalk) and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$335,000; AIL-00001, Traffic Calming (B-21099 Electronic Speed Signs Rolando Park Area) and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$18,000; and AIH-00001, Installation of City Owned Street

Lights (B-19079 Reo Drive New Streetlights) and to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$270,000, within fund 600001, Grant Fund State.
