A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVING THE FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE LEASE FOR THE CITY COMMUNICATIONS FACILITY ON THE UNITED STATES NAVY'S CONSOLIDATED AREA RADIO TRUNKING SYSTEM COMPLEX AND RELATED ACTIONS IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) proposes to amend its existing lease with the United States Navy for a portion of the real property commonly known as the Consolidated Area Radio Trunking System Complex (Navy Property) to allow the City to relocate two antennas to a different tower on the Navy Property in order to achieve better signal strength and radio coverage for first responders and regional fire agencies and to increase the annual rent to compensate the Navy for the City's use of the additional space on the Navy Property (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, under that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of projects that have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City's Planning Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities)

and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the Project involves the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines section 15301.
2. That an exception to the categorical exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, does not apply.


