A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA'S CALIFORNIANS FOR ALL INITIATIVE FOR THE CITY'S YOUTH WORKFORCE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, "California Volunteers" is the state office tasked with engaging Californians in service, volunteering, and civic action to tackle California's most pressing challenges while mobilizing all Californians to volunteer and serve in their communities; and

WHEREAS, the "Californians for All" service initiative was launched in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to build on the efforts of California Volunteers to establish a statewide volunteer corps to help with the state's response to emergencies and disasters; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, California Volunteers solicited applications from cities for Californians for All grant funding around the areas of workforce development, climate change, food insecurity, and COVID-19 recovery. The City of San Diego's grant proposal to create opportunities for youth in the areas of workforce development, with wraparound services which address housing, food insecurities, and eliminate barriers for youth to succeed, was successful and the State provided a letter of intent to award the City \$18,584,147 to administer the program; and

WHEREAS, the City's Youth Workforce Program is built upon on a current, robust, and successful internship, apprentice, and volunteer program. Youth will have the ability to work in many areas across various City departments, working to achieve existing departmental missions and contributing to the City's work on climate change, food insecurity, and COVID-19 recovery. The City will also lean on existing, successful partnerships dedicated to creating opportunities

for youth in the areas of workforce development, wraparound services which address housing,

food insecurities, and eliminate barriers for youth to succeed; and

WHEREAS, this is a cost-reimbursement grant, and the grant program leverages

100 percent State Fiscal Recovery Funds. The City will be required to submit periodic and timely

invoices to the State for expenses already incurred for processing and payment. The City will be

required to report expenditures and unliquidated obligations associated with the grant; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized to make application to the Californians for All initiative and to take all

necessary actions to secure funding for an amount not to exceed \$18,584,147 in State grant funds

for the City's Youth Workforce Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept,

appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$18,584,147 in grant funds from the

Californians for All initiative over a two-year period ending May 1, 2024, for the City's Youth

Workforce Program.
