A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FEDERAL CARES ACT
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR A
SAFE PARKING PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING A NON-
PROFIT AGREEMENT WITH JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE
FOR THE SAFE PARKING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, since 2017, the City of San Diego has provided funding for the Safe Parking Program (Program), which provides a safe and secure location for individuals and families residing in their vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Program has been administered by Jewish Family Service through a contract with the San Diego Housing Commission; and

WHEREAS, in 2021, the City established the Homelessness Strategies and Solutions Department (Department) and tasked the Department with increasing coordination, oversight, and effectiveness of homelessness services and programs throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to contract directly with Jewish Family Service to minimize administrative functions, increase access to data, and enhance overall coordination of the Program; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, the federal government passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act that allocates federal economic relief and stimulus funds to the Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG-CV), to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, the City allocates U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) entitlement grant funds based on the Fiscal Years 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan), adopted by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) with San Diego Resolution R-312442, effective April 26, 2019, which assesses community development and affordable housing needs and identifies seven high priority goals, including the goal to assist individuals and families gain stable housing after experiencing homelessness or a housing crisis by providing appropriate housing and service solutions grounded in best practices; and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2020, Council adopted San Diego Resolution R-313042, allocating an initial round of CDBG-CV funds, as well as approving substantial amendments to the Consolidated Plan and FY 2020 Action Plan to include the CDBG-CV funds; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2020, Council adopted San Diego Resolution R-313256, allocating an additional round of CDBG-CV funds, and approving a second substantial amendment to the Consolidated Plan and the FY 2020 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to allocate \$444,000 in CDBG-CV funds previously identified for administrative purposes to support the Program; NOW

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego (Council), as follows:

1. CDBG-CV funds in an amount not to exceed \$444,000 are allocated from the CDBG-CV Grant 1000651-2021, Fund 600000 for the operation of the Safe Parking Program as defined in the agreement with Jewish Family Service identified below, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer certifying that the CDBG-CV funds are available.

2. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to execute a non-profit agreement with Jewish Family Service (Agreement), on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 314195, for the operating period of July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023 to provide homelessness prevention and shelter diversion services to persons experiencing homelessness in the City of San Diego, on terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement, as it may be amended upon advice of the City Attorney's Office, for a total amount of \$1,436,797, consisting of \$992,797 of Homeless Housing Assistance and Prevention Round 3 grant funds and \$444,000 in CDBG-CV funding.
3. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to execute all documents and instruments that are necessary or appropriate to implement this Resolution, in a form and format approved by the City Attorney, and to take such actions necessary or appropriate to implement this Resolution.
4. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to substitute funding sources or increase compensation for the Agreement during the fiscal year, if necessary, without further action by the Council, but only if and to the extent that funds are determined to be available for such purposes.
5. City staff is requested to return to City Council prior to September 30, 2022, with an assessment of potential safe parking sites in each Council district, plans to create designated family-friendly zones in each of the City's safe parking sites, and plans for funding additional safe parking sites and services in the

City's application for Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention round 4
grant.
