A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE NON-PROFIT AGREEMENT WITH JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE FOR THE SAFE PARKING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2022, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) approved Resolution R-314195 approving the Non-Profit Agreement with Jewish Family Service to operate the City's Safe Parking Program (Agreement) at three locations in the City of San Diego, which provides individuals living out of their vehicles with a safe place to stay overnight and services to navigate them toward long-term housing; and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2022, the Council approved Resolution R-314516 approving the First Amendment to the Non-Profit Agreement with Jewish Family Service (First Amendment) to increase the compensation and include additional services; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement as amended, the initial term extends through June 30, 2023 (Initial Term); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) seeks to enter into the Second Amendment to the Non-Profit Agreement with Jewish Family Service (Second Amendment) to expand the Safe Parking Program to a fourth location at the Rose Canyon Operation Yard, to include camper trailers and safe parking, and to increase the compensation in the Second Amendment by \$474,003 for a total compensation in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,332,073 during the Initial Term; and

WHEREAS, the City further seeks to extend the existing term of the Agreement to allow for three additional one-year option periods (each such one-year period, an "Option Period") and

increase the total compensation available to Jewish Family Service during each Option Period in an amount not to exceed \$2,828,070; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to execute the Second Amendment to include additional services at the Rose Canyon Operation Yard, to increase the compensation by \$474,003 for a total compensation in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,332,073 during the Initial Term, and to amend the Agreement to allow for three additional one-year option periods, as set forth in the Second Amendment on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR-314670.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or designee, is authorized during each Option Period to amend the Agreement to increase the total compensation to an amount not-to-exceed \$2,828,070 contingent on available funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an additional amount of \$474,003 under the Second Amendment for total compensation in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,332,073 during the Initial Term and \$2,828,070 during each Option Period, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriations Ordinance for the applicable

fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
