A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THREE AS-NEEDED AGREEMENTS WITH GEI CONSULTANTS, INC. (H2225952), HDR ENGINEERING, INC. (H2225953), AND STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES, INC. (H225954) FOR CIVIL ENGINEERING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO DAMS AND RELATED ACTIONS

WHEREAS, the City utilizes as-needed engineering services agreements to perform various engineering support services in support of operations and maintenance projects, the execution of its Capital Improvement Program (CIP), and ancillary projects; and

WHEREAS, the City's Engineering and Capital Projects (E&CP) Department uses asneeded consultants to provide professional services within specific disciplines for various projects citywide; and

WHEREAS, the City's Dams and Reservoirs are in need of major retrofit or replacement in order to comply with current seismic standards and requirements imposed by the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) and specifically DWR's Division of Safety of Dams (DSOD); and

WHEREAS, each project requires multi-discipline engineering to design repairs and replacements including hydrology, hydraulics, geotechnical, structural, mechanical, electrical, and civil engineering; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2021, E&CP requested proposals from qualified firms for as-needed engineering services, including performing condition assessments, professional design services for repair or upgrade, engineering estimates, permit documents, construction plans and specifications, design support services during the construction phase and close-out, and

regulatory compliance efforts involving efforts associated to regulatory requirements involving the Environment Protection Agency, State of California Regional Water Control Board (Division of Drinking Water) and Water Resources Board (Division of Safety of Dams); and

WHEREAS, based on selection rating criteria and procedures, E&CP selected GEI Consultants, Inc. (H2225952), HDR Engineering, Inc. (H2225953) and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (H2225954) (collectively, Consultants) as the top three qualified firms to award asneeded agreements to; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreements with the Consultants each have a minimum aggregate value of \$1,000 and a total not-to-exceed amount of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000), for a duration of five (5) years (Agreements); and

WHEREAS, the work to be performed under these Agreements will be completed on a task-by-task basis, and are required to address the City's needs to meet required schedules and satisfy regulatory conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Agreements with GEI Consultants Inc. (H2225954), HDR Engineering, Inc. (H2225953), and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (H2225954) to provide as-needed civil engineering services with an emphasis on dam designs for a minimum of \$1,000 (\$3,000 for all three contracts) and a total amount not to exceed \$7,000,000 (\$21,000,000 for all three contracts) for the duration of five years under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file

in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR 14679; RR 314679; and RR 314679; and RR-314679.

- 2. The Mayor, or designee, is authorized to execute and deliver the Agreements; and
- 3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$21,000,000, with \$7,000,000 for each agreement, with a minimum guarantee coming from Fund 700011 (Water Utility Operating), requiring these services for the purposes of funding the Agreements, contingent upon the adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year and contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
