A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING FUNDS TO SAN DIEGO CONTINUING EDUCATION FOUNDATION DBA SAN DIEGO COLLEGE OF CONTINUING EDUCATION FOUNDATION; SAN DIEGO HABITAT FOR HUMANITY, INC.; SAN DIEGO REGIONAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE; AND UNITED WAY OF SAN DIEGO, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 establishes guidelines and uniform eligibility requirements for funding Community Projects, Programs, and Services with non-profit community organizations and public agencies for community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) received and evaluated four applications for Community Projects, Programs, and Services funding for the following purposes:

San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce	Impacts of Housing Costs on Workforce and Employers	Helps create change by sharing the negative impacts of high housing costs.

United Way of San Diego	SD Shortfall Equity Simulator	Increases awareness regarding inequity in San Diego.

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 6 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to San Diego Continuing Education Foundation dba San Diego College of Continuing Education Foundation for new IT infrastructure, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 6 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to San Diego Habitat for Humanity, Inc. for cameras, door sensors, monitors, and three exterior doors, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 6 recommends an allocation of \$20,000 to San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce for public outreach expenses and professional services, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council District 6 recommends an allocation of \$6,000 to United Way of San Diego for equity content changes, IT installation, and development upgrades, as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Attorney has drafted this resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocations described in this resolution are made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or their designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2023 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and (1) San Diego Continuing Education Foundation dba San Diego College of Continuing Education Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, (2) San Diego Habitat for Humanity, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, (3) San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce in an amount not to exceed \$20,000, and (4) United Way of San Diego in an amount not to exceed \$6,000, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 314863-1 for San Diego Continuing Education Foundation dba San Diego College of Continuing Education Foundation, Document No. RR- 314863-2 for San Diego Habitat for Humanity, Inc., Document No. RR- 314863-3 for San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce, and Document No. RR - 314863-4 for United Way of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$36,000 from Council District 6: Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, G/L Account No. 512059, Cost Center 1106110006, all to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreements, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.


