DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 1 1 2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING A PROGRAM MANAGER
POSITION IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY FROM
THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2024, the Civil Service Commission of the City of San Diego reviewed a request from the Office of the City Attorney (Department) to exempt a Program Manager position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Program Manager position will manage and oversee projects related to firearm-prohibiting policies and procedures. This position will serve as the lead point of contact for supporting and implementing firearm-prohibiting policies, programs, practices, and priorities within the City, county, and statewide in order to help reduce and prevent firearms violence; advise Department staff and key leaders countywide on interpreting and applying policies and procedures addressing firearms violence prevention; guide firearm prohibition and relinquishing efforts led by the Department; manage special projects and conduct research to implement firearms violence prevention policies; develop and administer policies for the San Diego Regional Gun Violence Response Taskforce (Taskforce) to comply with state law related to gun prohibiting orders; and assist with managing the operations of the Taskforce which was created to enforce protective orders prohibiting gun possession; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City Charter (Charter) section 117 states the Unclassified Service shall include “[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority

and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council”; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the position, as described by the Department, the Civil Service Commission found it meets the intent of Charter section 117 to exempt the position from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding by the Civil Service Commission is set forth in the memorandum dated April 8, 2024, to the Honorable Council President and members of the Council, prepared on behalf of the Civil Service Commission by the Personnel Director, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21819; and

WHEREAS, the Department has drafted this ordinance based on the information provided by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete, true, and accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Charter section 117, the Council exempts from the Classified Service the Program Manager position in the Office of the City Attorney whose duties and responsibilities were reviewed by the Civil Service Commission, as described in the memorandum on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 21819.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
