A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN
JEREMIAH KEILAN JENKINS AND THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, Jeremiah Keilan Jenkins filed suit against the City of San Diego, alleging the wrongful death of his mother on November 27, 2018, as a result of an alleged failure to provide timely medical care while in police custody. The suit is entitled *Jeremiah Keilan Jenkins v. City of San Diego, et al.*, United States District Court No. 19cv2123 CAB (Litigation); and

WHEREAS, in Closed Session on December 11, 2023, the City Council, by the following votes: Yeas, Districts 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9; Nays, None; Vacant, District 4; authorized settlement of the Litigation for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below and pursuant to such other terms more fully set forth in the settlement agreement; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Council:

1. Authorizes the Mayor or his designee to pay the sum of \$875,000.00 from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045, in settlement of each and every claim for damages, interest, costs, and fees of any type, against City of San Diego, its agents and employees, arising from the Litigation;

2. Authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to expend an amount not to exceed \$875,000.00 from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045, for the purpose of settling this Litigation.
