A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING APPOINTMENTS TO THE
HOMELESSNESS REVENUE ACCOUNT CITIZENS
OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

RECITALS

The Council of the City of San Diego (Council) adopts this Resolution based on the following:

A. San Diego Municipal Code sections 26.2401 through 26.2403 established and set forth the duties and functions of the Homelessness Revenue Account Citizens Oversight Committee (Committee). The Committee serves as an advisory body to the Mayor and Council on the use of funds in the Homelessness Revenue Account.

B. The Committee shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council, and who shall serve without compensation. The Committee shall also include three ex officio members: the Independent Budget Analyst or designee; the Chief Financial Officer or designee; and the Director of the Homelessness Strategies and Solutions Department, or successor department, or designee.

C. A majority of the members of the Committee shall possess expertise in one or more of the following areas: government, municipal or public finance, non-profit management, business, lived experience in homelessness, philanthropic funding, or related fields. No member shall have an ownership interest or private profit interest in a for-profit company that may seek either an allocation of Transient Occupancy Tax revenues for homelessness programs or a contract with the City using these tax revenues for homelessness programs. Further, no member shall be an employee or representative of an organization, whether for-profit or non-profit, that

may seek either an allocation of these tax revenues for homelessness programs or a contract with the City using these tax revenues for homelessness programs.

D. Members shall serve four-year terms, and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed. Initial members shall be appointed so that the terms of no more than four members shall expire in any year to allow the terms of the Committee members to be staggered. For the initial appointments, three members shall be appointed to an initial term that will expire in 2028, and four members shall be appointed to an initial term that will expire in 2030. Members whose initial appointments are less than a full term of four years will be allowed to serve two full terms in addition to the partial term.

E. Any vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term. Any member appointed to fill a vacancy will be eligible to serve the remaining term of the vacant position and two full terms.

F. The Office of the City Attorney prepared this Resolution based on the information provided by City staff, including information provided by affected third parties and verified by City staff, with the understanding that this information is complete and accurate.

ACTION ITEMS


Be it resolved by the Council of the City of San Diego:

1. The following appointment by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as a member of the Homelessness Revenue Account Citizens Oversight committee, for the term expiring as indicated, is made and hereby confirmed:


