


Survey Implementation Facts


- · July 9, 2012—July 25, 2012
- n = 816 (includes 121 cell-phone only respondents)
- City of San Diego residents = 400 (oversample)
- Weighted for City residents and cell-phone only respondents
- Margin of Error= +/- 3.4% overall(@ 95% confidence)--+/- 4.9% City of San Diego






Public's Trust in Ability of Water Agencies to Provide Clean, Safe Water



Frequency of Drinking Bottled or Tap Water






Opinion of Using Multiple Water Sources and Programs/Diversification






Believe that Drinking Water Already Contains Recycled Water




Reasons for Belief that Drinking Water Already Contains Recycled Water

Strongly/Somewhat Favor Use of Advanced Treated Recycled Water as an Addition to Drinking Water Supply



(among 64% who did not indicate that they strongly favor such use for recycled water)






