Mayor Wilson called the Special Meeting to order at 2:14 p.m.

Roll Call was taken.

Councilman Martinet entered the Chambers.

Councilman Williams entered the Chambers.

The hour of 2:00 p.m. having arrived, the Mayor announced this was the time
and place set for the hearing on Citizen Participation in the development of, and
the opportunity to voice their views on, the contents of the City of San Diego's
Community Development Block Grant Application under Title I of the Housing and
Community Development Act of 1974.

(Item 1 - Continued)

City Manager Moore, Senior Chief Deputy City Attorney Fitzpatrick, and James A. Lester, Program Development and Administration, answered questions directed by the Council.

Jesse Albritten, Elena Savala, Peggy Smith, Edna Wheeler, Bernice Fox, Emogene Wood, Loch Crane, Charles Bollard, Roland Reed, Abran Quevedo, Stewart Shaw, Roberta Frank, Ruby Zellman, Warren Nielsen, Reverend Suitonu, Reverend Willie Harris, Bill Calkins, Noel Neudeck, Pat Stalmaker, and Maria Elena Quintero appeared to speak.

The motion of Councilman Hubbard to allocate \$150,000 from Growth Management Study to the elderly and handicapped, failed due to lack of five affirmative votes by the following vote: Yeas-Councilmen Hubbard and Ellis. Nays-Councilmen Johnson, O'Connor, Williams, Morrow, Martinet, Bates, and Mayor Wilson. Absent-None.

The motion of Councilman Martinet to close the hearing, adopt the proposed Resolutions, (1) Authorizing the City Manager to execute and file the grant application; and (2) Authorizing the City Manager to execute and submit to HUD a request for a 10% advance of funds in the amount of \$910,000 for the purpose of continuing previously-approved Model Cities projects, undertaking necessary program planning, and preparing for the implementation of activities as listed in the grant application, was not voted on at this time.

Councilman Hubbard left the Chambers.

Senior Chief Deputy City Attorney Fitzpatrick and Deputy City Manager Lockwood answered questions directed by the Council.

The hearing was closed and the following Resolutions adopted on motion of Councilman Martinet:

RESOLUTION 212090, authorizing the City Manager to submit a grant application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for financial assistance under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, including all certifications and assurances required by that Act and under the terms and conditions set forth in the form of application; and

RESOLUTION 212091, authorizing the City Manager to execute and submit to the Department of Housing and Urban Development a request for a 10 percent advance of funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 in the amount of \$915,000, for the purpose of continuing previously approved Model Cities projects, undertaking necessary program planning, and preparing for the implementation of activities as listed in the City of San Diego Community Development Block Grant Application.

Councilmen Bates, O'Connor, and Morrow left the Chambers.

Roland Reed, Dr. Tapia, and Marian Bear appeared to speak.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the Special Meeting was adjourned at 5:05 p.m. on motion of Councilman Williams.
