Section 2. That in the event the zoning restrictions shall attach to the said land described in Section 1 of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 11182 (New Series), adopted December 13, 1973, of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego, be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefor was made prior to the date of adoption of this ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 103-0401 RELATING TO THE BOUNDARY OF THE GASLAMP QUARTER PLANNED DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:
